Board Meeting- Media Summary

Board members were recognized for their service as a part of School Board Appreciation Week.

The board approved the consent agenda, which included the minutes of the January 21, 2021 regular meeting, payment of bills, and the January financial report. The board also heard an administrative report.

The board received comments from district patrons about the potential four-day school week. These comments generated discussion both in favor of and opposed to the potential calendar.

Under New Business:

The board approved the district's professional development program evaluation and the curriculum program evaluation. The board approved an E-Rate contract for district hardware updates, which will save the district 60% of the total costs required for the updates. A mid-year budget update was presented and compared to this time last year. Currently, our revenues are up 8% and our expenditures are up 13% due to COVID funds and required COVID purchases. The state withheld our full formula money in July and we are currently only receiving 91% of what we should receive from the state at this time. It is projected that we will receive 94% of our projected funds by the end of the school year. The board then viewed a presentation of the four-day school week along with survey results and a rough draft of the school calendar. No action was taken on the four-day school week at this time.

The board held an executive session taking the following actions:

Approved a contract for Darian Eggleston to serve as kindergarten teacher for the 2021-2022 school year.
