

Strasburg C-3 Board of Education
March 18, 2021
Board Meeting- Media Summary

The board approved the consent agenda, which included the minutes of the February 18, 2021 regular meeting, payment of bills, and the February financial report. The board also heard an administrative report.

Old Business:

The Board of Education approved the 2021-2022 School Year Calendar.

Under New Business:

The Board approved the food service program evaluation and the health services program evaluation. The Board discussed and approved QNS infrastructure work costing the district \$14,000.00. This will increase Wi-Fi speeds in the building, we will receive 60% of those costs back in the form of rebates from our e-rate participation. Bids were awarded for snow removal, mowing, and propane for the 2021-2022 school year. The new CSIP was presented and received board approval. The CSIP will drive the direction of the district for the next five years.

The board approved to cap board paid insurance at a rate of \$600/employee/month, the current cap is \$560/month/employee. The increase is due to a 7.5% rate increase for the 2021-2022 school year. Under insurance, the board also approved to provide a \$25,000 board paid life insurance policy for all staff members. This benefit will cost the district a total of \$600 dollars/year.
