

Strasburg C-3 Board of Education
June 17, 2021
Board Meeting- Media Summary

The board approved the consent agenda, which included the minutes of the May 20, 2021, regular meeting, payment of bills, and the March financial report. The board also heard an administrative report.

Under Administrative Report:

The board received an update on ESSER II and ESSER III funding.

ESSER II: We have received these funds from the Federal Government and have made the following purchases with those funds: the new district phone system, upgrades to the district server-including new hot spot access points throughout the building, and curriculum camp stipends for teachers.

ESSER III: Strasburg C-3 is slated to receive \$301,093 to be used over the next three years. While ARP ESSER requires that a minimum of 20% of the LEA's allocation be spent on addressing the students' academic, social, emotional, and mental health needs due to the effect of lost instructional time, the remaining LEA funds may be used for a wide range of activities to address needs arising from the pandemic. Strasburg C-3 will be using a majority of these funds to improve student academic achievement. The budget and grant application are currently a work in progress.

Under Old Business:

Mrs. Mayfield provided an update on the current fiscal year budget. Our June 30, 2021 project fund balance is \$1,268,327.00.

Under New Business:

Katey Summer was awarded the parents as teachers and speech pathology contract for the 2021-2022 school year. Next, the board voted to increase student breakfast and lunch prices. Breakfast will increase from \$1.50 to \$1.60; lunch will increase from \$2.10 to \$2.20. At this time, all students will still receive free meals through the Seamless Summer Food Program. Third, the board approved the purchase of I-Ready Software, a student academic benchmarker that will be implemented K-8 for the next three years. Fourth, the 2021-2022 Safe Return to School Plan (SRCSP) received board approval. Finally, the board approved the 2021-2022 District Budget.
